



The Regulator

Always keep in mind to:

- Replace if it shows signs of **wear and tear**, or **does not fit properly with the cylinder**.
- Check for **leaks** every time you connect to a cylinder.
- Replace after **10** years.



Flexible Hoses

- **Use only certified hoses** which bear the year and name of the manufacturer.
- Keep hose lengths as **short as possible**.
- Secure hoses with **proper hose clips**.
- Replace any hoses when they **expire**.
- Replace any hoses showing signs of **wear, cracking or damage**.
- Never use a **naked flame** to search for leaks.



IN THE EVENT OF FIRE

1. Immediately raise the alarm and call the **Fire Brigade (112)** advising them of the presence of LPG

Using Liquigas Cylinders Safely



DO

- ✓ Take care of the cylinder and the valve to ensure that they are **not damaged**.
- ✓ Always use cylinders in the **upright position**.



- ✓ Return cylinders when **empty** or when not in use for **long periods**.
- ✓ **Read the instructions provided** with your appliance and keep them handy for future reference.

- ✓ Keep your appliance **clean and have it serviced regularly** by a competent person.

- ✓ Ensure there is an **adequate supply of fresh air** where your appliance is used. If a room becomes stuffy, open a window or door immediately.



- ✓ **Preferably replace empty cylinders for full ones outdoors. In case of a change indoors take extra care and precaution.** The appliance must also be switched off and preferably allowed to cool.
- ✓ Check that the **regulator is connected properly** and that there is no gas leakage.



DON'T

- ✓ Don't expose the cylinder to **direct heat** from flame as this may result in excessive pressure.
- ✓ Don't attempt to **unscrew or disconnect** a clip-on from any cylinder if the **flame does not go out when the regulator is turned off**.



- ✓ **Don't store or use cylinders in cellars, below ground level or closer than 2 metres from entrapped drains, unsealed gullies or openings to cellars.** LPG is heavier than air and if there is a leak gas will accumulate at a low level and may become dangerous in presence of a flame or spark.

- ✓ **Don't attempt to force a regulator of one size on to a cylinder's valve of another size.** In case of difficulty, contact your retailer and have the appliance checked.

- ✓ **Don't modify your gas appliance.** Always ask your gas retailer for advice and do not let unqualified people tamper with or service your appliance.

- ✓ **Don't obstruct access to cylinders.**
